


Polish Report of Activities 10.2011 – 10.2015

The Association of Polish Artists and Designers (Związek Polskich Artystów Plastyków – ZPAP) is an association of professional visual artists. It is an organization with long tradition, since it was established in 1911.

ZPAP represents artists concerned with such fields of arts as painting, sculpture, graphics, design, restoration of historical monuments and new media. It is active in the whole territory of Poland, where it has 22 regions. 2011 – anniversary 100 year of ZPAP – activity: competition for best poster, monography "New Translation in Color – History of ZPAP 1911 – 2011" under redaction Maria Moroz and Agata Gąsiorek. Exhibitions and symposiums in Kraków, Warszawa, Wrocław, Gdańsk

2015- Polish National Committee IAA/AIAP call up new president Janusz Janowski and prepare new plan of action.

The Association of Polish Artists and Designers (ZPAP) and Polish National Committee IAA/AIAP in this period realized:

1. Co – operation with the state organs and with the state administration in the development, implementation of the legal regulations that are of great significance for the circles of visual artists.

- Copyright Agency ZPAP 2015 ZPAP establish and confirmed new document Rules- Collective management and protection of copyright and of the associated rights related to the works of art and exercising the powers under the law on copyright and the associated rights.
- In 2015 Minister of Culture and National Heritage appointed President of Polish Artists Association of the Council of Non-governmental Organizations.
- 2. Co operation with cultural, artistic, academic institutions in Poland and abroad:
- New steps for acceptance IAA Card in Poland; meetings with Art Council of Polish Museums and with Polish National Committee Unesco).
- Status of artists.
- Supporting the development and popularization of artistic creation, attracting a wide range of its recipients, as well advocating the idea of artistic patronage.
- 3. Publishing activity
- New website www.zpap.org.pl. Providing information on ZPAP and IAA membership and on practicing artistic profession (<u>www.zpap.org.pl</u>).
- Organizing exhibitions, competitions, workshops, as well as any activities aimed at the presentation of professional achievements.
- 4. Conducting business activity aimed at financing the realization of the statutory objectives.
