**\*\*\* PLEASE NOTE – IMPORTANT \*\*\***

For one official Delegate of each IAA Europe National Committee participating at the Symposium "Exhibition Remuneration Right in Europe" and at the General Assembly, the office of IAA Europe will book a free single hotel room incl. breakfast for the night before the symposium, that is the night of 21 November 2018.

The IAA Europe office will make a group booking for this at Motel One Brussels. The costs for this night will be covered by IAA Europe. That means, this one official delegate will not need to book a room for that night himself/herself.

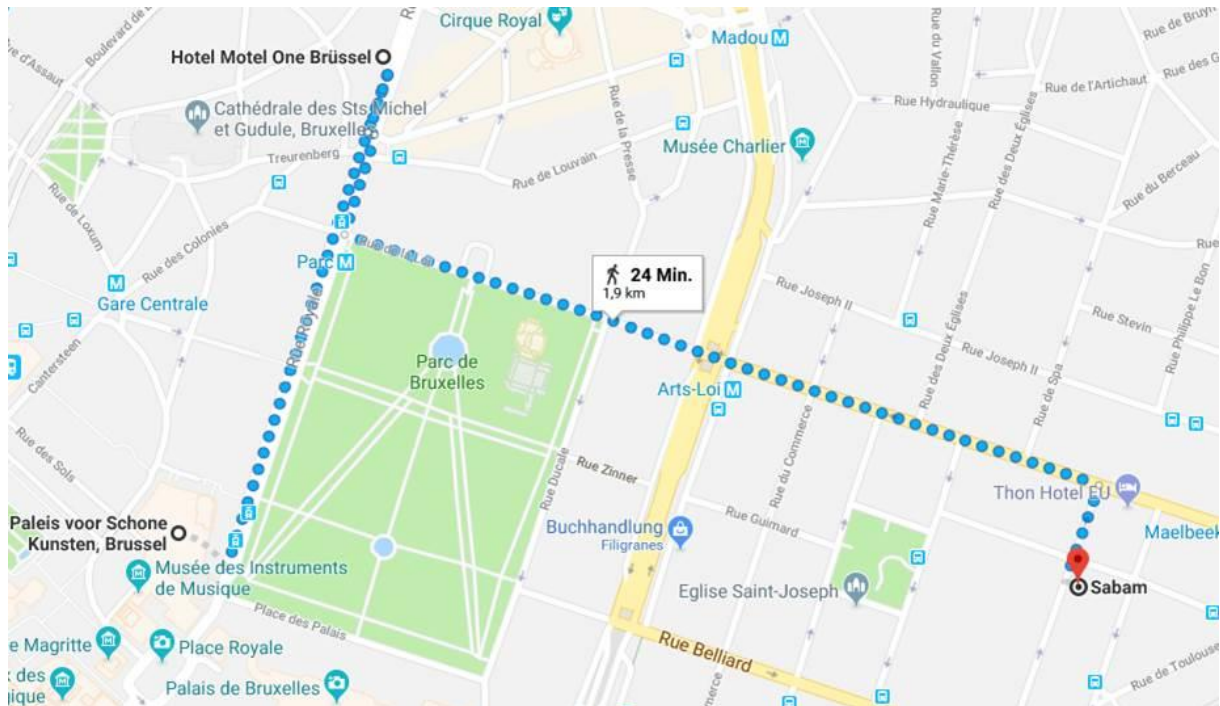
