



Poland Report of Activities 10.2017– 10.2018

The Association of Polish Artists and Designers (ZPAP)/
Polish National Committee IAA/AIAP

The Association of Polish Artists and Designers (Związek Polskich Artystów Plastyków – ZPAP) is an association of professional visual artists. It is an organization with long tradition, since it was established in 1911.

ZPAP represents artists concerned with such fields of arts as painting, sculpture, graphics, design, restoration of historical monuments and new media. It is active in the whole territory of Poland, where it has 21 branches /10.2018/

The Association of Polish Artists and Designers (ZPAP) and Polish National Committee IAA/AIAP in this period realized:

I.Cooperation with the state authorities and with the state administration in the development, implementation of the legal regulations that are of great significance for the circles of visual artists;

A. Nationwide Cultural Conferences / 2017-2018/ Kraków, Gdańsk, Warszawa are the basis for the project of new legislative solutions. ZPAP participates in the survey regarding the social situation and the number of artists in Poland

B. ZPAP OZZ -Collective Management Organization –agreement of the resale rights /droit de suite/ between ZPAP Association of Polish Artists and Designers and professional dealers in art.

The Agreement on the conditions and the terms of payment of the remuneration referring to the professional resales of the original works to the authors / and their heirs/ was signed on the 9th of MAY 2018. Signatories twenty entities /auction houses, galleries of art /- members of the Association of the Polish Antiquaries and Dealers of Art [SAiMP] representing about 35% of the Polish Art Market. This is big success after years of efforts and negotiations .

II.Cooperation with cultural, artistic, association and institutions in Poland and abroad:

A. Around 250 exhibitions and artistic events took place in 21 ZPAP regions.

B. Activities for free admission to galleries and museums- acceptance IAA Card in Poland; meetings with Art Council of Polish Museums and with Polish National Committee UNESCO,

C. ZPAP represent Polish National Committee IAA/AIAP, Maria Moroz vice-president N.C Poland is member IAA Executive Committee Europe and IAA/AIAP Executive Committee World.

III. Supporting the development and popularization of artistic creation, attracting a wide range of its recipients, as well advocating the idea of artistic patronage
